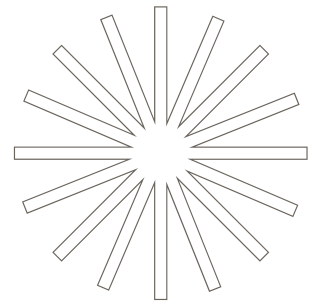

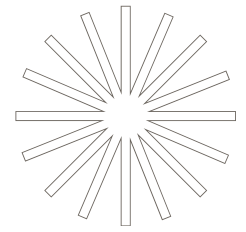


## Reflecting on the bitter truth of Gender Based Violence

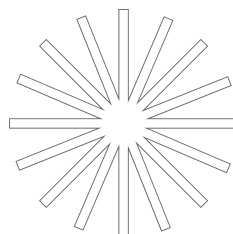
The first workshop done at Women's Christian College by our community leaders on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

Consistently generating scope for a wider range of industrial exposure and placement opportunities through the employer engagement programmes for our students.

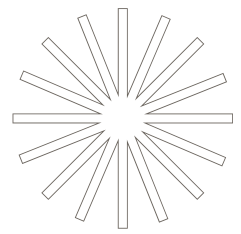
